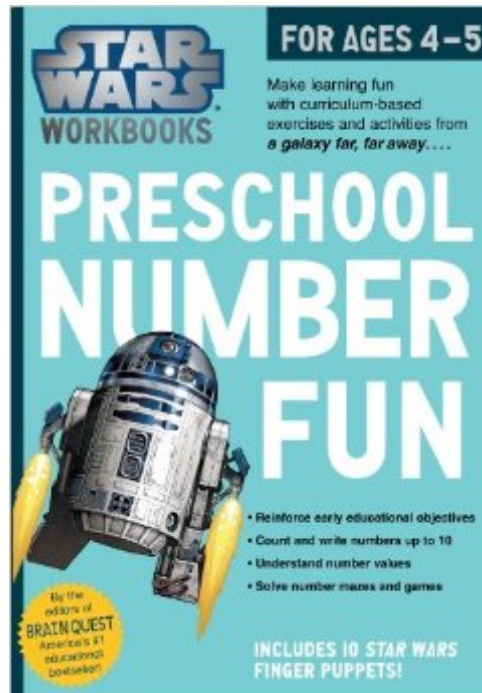

My four year old son LOVES this book. He has never been interested in practicing writing, the alphabet or math with me. He always gets goofs off and whines to do something else, but this has held his attention. When I first gave it to him, he couldn't wait to start and when we had to leave he didn't want to put it down. He had preschool this last year and has one more year ahead of him and I definitely think that reviewing this and other star wars workbooks over the summer will help him keep his knowledge up so he can start learning new material next year instead of spending the first half of the year in review. The activities are simple and colorful and even though they just seem fun to the child, they really do get harder as the workbook goes on and challenge the child to remember things he has learned previously in the book. I am super pleased with this purchase and excited to try the other categories of books that are offered.

My wife teaches kindergarten. She loves these books and so do her Kinders, who get copies of the pages to work on. Educational and topical. Have to get and keep their interest after all. Everyone knows Star Wars!

My 4YO likes it. Definitely gets him interested in numbers because of the Star Wars connection. The only drawback is that there isn't enough printed practice/guided numbers to write over. There are only a few and then when he's feeling confident, there are no more.

If your child enjoys Star Wars, and you would like to expose them to additional numbers practice, this is the workbook for you! My son (age 4) was SO engaged with the workbook, he would BEG us to work on some pages, and he never wanted to stop. He could have continued to work in the book until it was completed, if we didn't have other requirements, such as sleep and food. Overall, I think the quality of the activities was strong, as well. I felt that he got excellent practice with counting and writing his numbers.

My daughter, age 5, is a huge Star Wars fan and loved this so much she tried to get through it in one sitting. A great way to capture her attention with fun Star Wars related items while she's learning. We both loved this workbook! My 3 year old loved it too and it was definitely challenging for her.
