

We found this book a great help in our son's preparation for the National Geographic Bee. This book gives a great start to understanding the basics of geography. We only got through part of the book before the school's bee. Next year my son will have completed the book, and the other book of Matt's, "The Handy Geography Answer Book". The combination of these two books will definitely increase your child's knowledge of the world. Matt gives some tips on how to do well in the bee, but most of the emphasis is on learning the material. There is no simple way to study for the bee. His advice on narrowing the answers was very helpful. We spent some time on learning the "superlatives". My son did not get any of those questions during the bee, but the knowledge of knowing the tallest, longest, biggest etc... is invaluable.

Our 4th grade son was accepted into his school's Geo Bee and we wanted to find something to help him review. This book is DEFINITELY it. It is almost information overload, but we were able to pick sections that we thought might come up at the Bee. Mostly U.S. and Continent stuff and he had a blast running in and quizzing us on what he was learning. All it did was show us how LITTLE we knew. Ugh. I definitely recommend this for anyone either reviewing for a Geo Bee or just wanting to know interesting facts about the world. Sorta nerdy, but we actually sit around some nights as a family and read through this together.

A slick, to-the-point guide for the National Geography Bee Competition (NGBC). It contains a fact sheet for each country, followed by several chapters of physical and social geography for each of those countries, with special emphasis on USA. A potential competitor will learn how to mentally

condition him/herself for the big day as well. The book also has guiding chapter for parents of the little competitors. The lesson given in each chapter of the book will enrich your geography knowledge whether you are competing for NGBC or not. The main drawback of this book is that it was published in 2001. Although the world has not changed completely, but it has to some extent as far as the Geography Bee is concerned. The problem with this book is that it does not have an updated version nor does it have a companion online presence that updated the more recent facts. With this addition, this book will be really helpful for all aspirants for the NGBC.

This geography bee book is the best on the market to help students win the bee. The chapters provide great information about the bee and how to study for it and the 1000 questions are written in true bee style. If your child can do well on the 1000 questions he or she is likely to do well at the state or local bee. Practice makes perfect; good luck!

Published in 2002, this book is now significantly out of date in a number of areas. Countries have split up or changed names. Although there are many useful review questions, students looking for review material in 2010 should look elsewhere. Edited to add: This book is ripe for a new edition, but online errata would go a long way to extending the useful life of this one.
