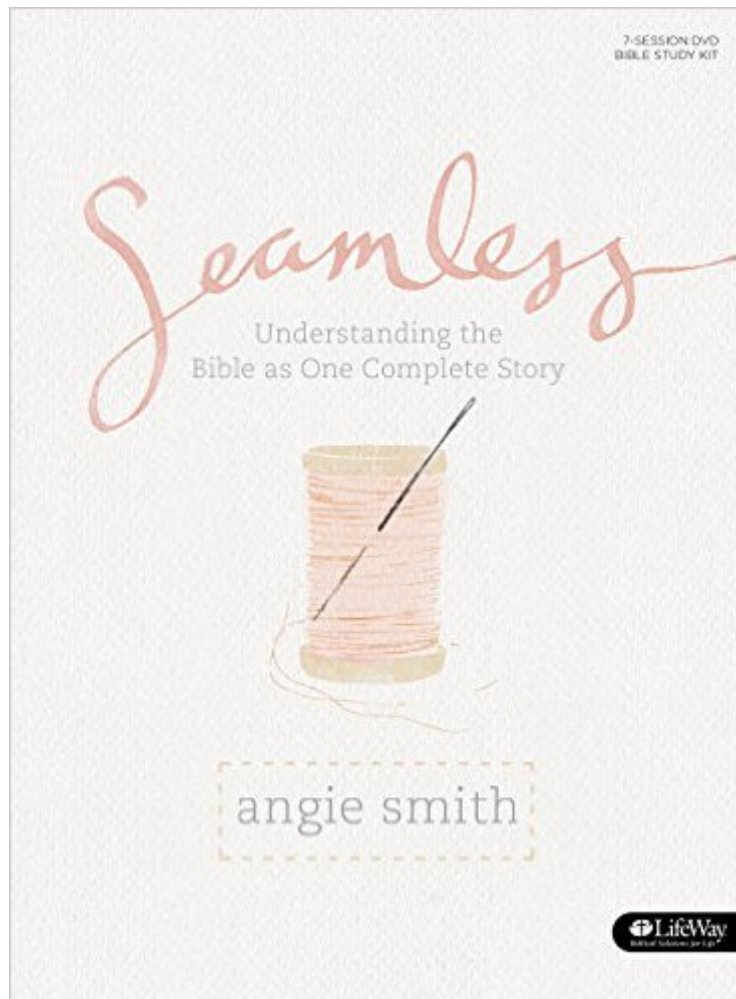


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Seamless: Understanding The Bible As One Complete Story (Member Book)

A little elementary for my needs, but this would be a very good Bible study for new Christians.

This study is a good overview of the Bible and has some thought-provoking points that led to great discussion in our group. Unfortunately, I give it only two stars because flippant and sarcastic comments, distract from the strength of the study. Here are some examples below. These examples may not bother some, but if they would distract you it may be a study you should avoid or simply be prepared to overlook some commentary. page 38 "Pops died in Haran..." page 39 "...Noah wouldn't have bothered getting hammered if he had... access to... sticky notes." page 39 "she was evidently a pretty hot lady... the Pharaoh falls in love with hottie Sarai." Sarai was Abram's sister "Eww". page 42 "Bless her elderly heart, that's a lot to take in with your Metamucil." "...after donkey-boy Ishmael is born.." page 44 "lying to the God of the universe is probably not an effective life strategy.." page 145 "If you're any kind of Christian, you've memorized the events in that chart and are ready to move on. Kidding. I'm kidding." page 148 "God bless him, Paul loves a little drama." page 151 "... I feel ..like telling Paul that going to Rome is going to turn out the same way it did for Rose on the Titanic. Leave the blue diamond, Paul. Just kiss it goodbye, because it's not going to be the Hallmark moment you've imagined... As a Roman citizen Paul obviously feels a calling to Rome." (Acts 23:11- Jesus tells Paul he must go to Rome..) Page 151 "...I think Paul is hilarious in his word choices. I get that he wants them to know that he's a devoted follower of Christ and yada yada yada, but please read Romans 1:11 and try to keep a straight face." page 152 "While Paul hangs out in jail, he writes letters to the church[es] in Ephesus... Philippi... Colosse.. and to an individual named Philemon.. he sure is an ambitious pen pal..." page 164 "...maybe you've studied the symbolism [of Revelation] for years and have written dissertations.. If that is the case, I want to personally thank you for spending the past few weeks with me and encourage you to leave. Now." The middle of the study was without as much sarcasm/humor but it increased again at the end. It is understandable to be accessible and funny but teachers of the Word of God need to be cautious (James 3:1). I hope Angie goes on to write many more Bible studies but hopefully with less sarcasm and flippancy, because she has a lot to offer.

Today was our last day for Seamless. Overall, it was ok. It is a great starting place for new Christians, but the stories she covers are well-known stories of the bible and lack depth. Personally, I needed something more. I also did not enjoy her tone throughout the study. She is very relaxed and often does not give the proper respect that the stories deserve. She refers to Jacob as Jake and at one point says that Paul could use therapy for PTSD. Her videos are wonderful, but are 15

minutes max.

My daughter & I participated in a small Bible study this summer and we used Seamless. We bought both the woman and teen versions. There is not a whole lot of difference between the two but it was nice for us to each have our own book to write in. This is the easiest to read & understand of all the Bible studies I have ever done. I would highly recommend it to everyone! --I want to add that we did watch the short videos at our study but they are NOT needed to do this study. All you need is this book and your Bible.

A wonderful walk through the Bible. It helps to tie everything together. I went to Bible college, yet she makes this simple for everyone to grasp how things are related and shows that the Bible isn't just a bunch of individual stories.

A great book with lots of answers, east to read & understand. Just make sure you get the adult version. I ended up with both & gave the other one away to my daughter even though it was the teenage/young adult/student version. I would recommend this to anyone that wants to understand the bible better.

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
